Homecoming Fall 2017 Parade Rules and Information

Theme: Braves Cancer Awareness!

Thursday, October 12, 2017

Parade begins 5:00 p.m.**

Each Group participating in Homecoming Parade must complete registration and return to Jeff Bohman—GCHS room 101 or email jeff.bohman@grant.kyschools.us

Deadline for Registration: Friday, October 6, 2017

Groups will receive confirmation and parade order by email on Monday, October 9, 2017.

Parade Route: Beginning in For Sale Lot next to Dry Ridge Outlet Mall; TL onto Fashion Ridge; TL onto Cull Rd; TR right on US 22; TR onto Warsaw Rd; TL into GCHS School; End in rear parking lot. Each group that needs to unload at the HS will turn left into the rear Gym Parking Lot to disembark. If group/float is not disembarking at the HS they will continue on entrance road making loop around by band practice field and turn right in front of the school exiting through new Tech Center entrance/exit.

1. Floats must be able to move at parade speed (about 5 mph) and be able to move faster in case of emergency.
2. Vehicle units may not have an unsafe number of riders. Groups must provide the number of riders with their registration or maximum number that float will hold.
3. If parade officials deem that groups float/vehicle is in any way unsafe or presents negative theme said groups float/vehicle will not be permitted to participate in parade.
4. The unit's contact person is responsible for the behavior of those on your unit at all times and must be present during the parade. Irresponsible and/or dangerous parade behavior includes, but is not limited to: riding, sitting, standing, climbing, or dancing on trailer rails, parade float walls, truck bed sidewalls, vehicle hoods, or other parts of a vehicle not intended to accommodate rides (for instance, on the hitch area of a gooseneck trailer).
5. This a family-oriented, community-based event. Music, visual displays should not exceed a "G" rating. If you have questions, please ask before the parade.
6. Use of grills, candles and other fire-burning objects are not permitted in the parade.
7. If your groups plans to throw items to the crowd keep in mind that no object when thrown should cause injury.
8. Encouraged items for your group/float: fire extinguisher; form of communication, and water. Absolutely no alcoholic beverages or smoking is permitted during the parade.
