Grant County High School Student Expectations

Starting the School Day:

- 1. Students will enter the building through the gym lobby entrance.
- 2. Students will remain in cafeteria or upper level of gym until dismissal at 8:00 am.
- 3. Students who enter the academic wing prior to 8:00 am will show teacher tutoring pass.
- 4. Students who enter the building after 7:55 am will have the opportunity to purchase "breakfast on the go" from food services.
- 5. Students will be permitted to take school purchased food items into the academic wing.
- 6. Students will throw away all food items and trash into appropriate containers.
- 7. Students will use restroom and visit individually assigned lockers prior to 8:10 am.
- 8. Students will be in classrooms prior to 8:10 am.
- 9. Students who remain in the hall after morning bell will report to the front office to receive a tardy slip.
- 10. Students will have no more than five minutes to report to class after tardy slip has been issued.

During the School Day:

- 1. Students are expected to remain in class.
- 2. Students out of class during the instructional period will wear a color coded hall pass.
- 3. Students will sign in and out of the classroom.
- 4. Students should minimize trips to their lockers in between classes to prevent a tardy to class.

Lunch Procedures:

- 1. Students will have the opportunity to use the restroom with their class before or after lunch.
- 2. Students are to remain with their teacher until they reach the cafeteria.
- 3. Students are to remain quiet in the hallway as they transition to the cafeteria.
- 4. Students are to enter the designated cafeteria doors.
- 5. Students are expected to remain in the cafeteria until their teacher announces dismissal.
- 6. Students are expected to remain seated unless throwing away trash.

Ending the School Day:

- 1. Students are expected to be clear of academic wing by 3:05 pm.
- 2. Students are expected to exit the building using the gym lobby exit only.

- 3. Students are expected to report straight to afternoon buses or designated supervised areas.
- Students entering the student parking lot must use school crosswalk located outside of gym lobby entrance.
- 5. Students staying for specific after school activities will need to be with their supervisor by 3:05 pm.

Miscellaneous:

- 1. Students will be expected to turn in bus passes, guidance office requests, library books, etc. during class change.
- 2. Students are expected to remain quiet while working in the library.

Assembly Procedures:

- 1. Students are expected to remain with class/grade level when being dismissed to the assembly.
- 2. Students are expected to remain quiet in the hallway as they transition to the assembly.
- 3. Students will not take food or drink into the assembly.
- 4. Students are expected to sit in their individual seat with feet on the floor, facing the front and attentive.
- 5. Students are expected to be an active listener and participant during the assembly and refrain from any conversation that is interruptive.
- 6. Students are expected to remain in their individual seats after the presentation until announcements are made for dismissal from assembly.
- 7. Students are expected to remain quiet in the hallway as they transition to the designated area.

Intervention:

- 1. Students are expected to arrive to class on time.
- 2. Students are expected to be prepared.
- 3. Students are expected to be an active participant during class.
