COLONEL CLAY LODGE #159, F. & A.M. SCHOLARSHIP RULES AND REGULATIONS

These rules and regulations governing the single \$1,000.00 (one thousand dollars) scholarship awarded annually by Colonel Clay Lodge are set forth to ensure the proper utilization of funds, as well as fairness and equality in awarding the Scholarship.

SECTION A:

- 1: The applicant must be a graduating senior of an accredited public high school in Kenton, Boone or Grant counties of the state of Kentucky.
- 2: Only two applications from each qualified high school shall be accepted per calendar year.
- 3: Each application must have a signed letter of recommendation from the high school guidance counselor.
- 4: Each applicant must complete the application form and submit it along with a transcript of the last 3 1/2 years of high school grades.
- 5: All applications **MUST** be postmarked or e-mailed by Friday, **08 April 2022** and received by Monday, **11 April 2022** to be considered.
- 6: No application shall be considered without:
 - a) the completed application form,
 - b) the current grade transcript,
 - c) the one page essay and
 - d) the signed letter of recommendation from the school guidance counselor.All items must be submitted together.

SECTION B:

- 1: All required forms and documentation will be submitted to an impartial scholarship committee comprised of members of the Colonel Clay Lodge Scholarship Fund.
- 2: The scholarship will be awarded to the candidate based on his or her objectives, high school transcript, essay and letter of recommendation from the high school guidance counselor.
- 3: All decisions of the scholarship committee and Colonel Clay Lodge shall be considered final and are not subject to review.

SECTION C:

The funds will be administered in the following manner:

- 1: Funds shall be paid on behalf of the student to the accredited college, university or trade / technical school of the student's choice.
- 2: The funds may be used for tuition, books and / or class fees. The funds may be used for housing fees only after tuition, books, and / or class fees are paid. No part of the funds may be used for recreation in any manner.
- 3: The selected applicant will receive a letter and phone call informing them of the outcome of the selection process by Wednesday, 11 May 2022.
