

Do I Qualify?

To qualify for the state-funded preschool program, children must reside in the Grant County School District and meet one of the following requirements set by the state of Kentucky:

3 year olds

Can qualify for the preschool program if they have a **delay or disability**. A preschool screening would be completed first to determine if your child may need a little more help or if they are developing on track.

4 year olds

Can qualify for the preschool program if they have a **delay or disability**. A preschool screening would be completed first to determine if your child may need a little more help of if they are developing on track.

OR

A child that turns 4 years old by August 1st 2021 can also qualify based on their household's annual **income**. (160% poverty level).

If your child does not meet the eligibility requirements for Grant County Preschool but you are still interested in enrolling them in a program, please contact Williamstown Independent Schools. They offer a Head Start program for children in the county and may be able to help you.
