

Do I Qualify?

To qualify for the state-funded preschool program, children must reside in the Grant County School District and meet one of the following requirements:

3 years olds:

Can qualify for the preschool program if they have a **delay or disability**. We do offer preschool screenings to help determine if your child may need a little more help or if they are progressing and developing on track.

4 years olds:

Can qualify for the preschool program if they have a **delay or disability**; screenings are also available for them.

or

A child that turns age 4 by August 1st of the school year can also qualify based on **income**. Please contact the preschool department at 859-824-3323 for those income guidelines (160% poverty level).

If your child does not meet the eligibility requirements for Grant County Preschool but you are still interested in enrolling them in a program, please contact Williamstown Independent Schools. They offer a Head Start program for children in the community. There are also eligibility requirements for this program but they are different than Grant County's requirements.
