Scholarship Qualifications and Guidelines

1. Must be a graduating senior and Grant County resident.
2. Must enter an accredited college or university of his or her choice.
3. Must fill out application and include essay. Winners will be required to submit a photo to accompany our reports and articles.
4. Must have a grade point average of 3.0 or better for the last two semesters. Please provide a recent transcript for verification.
5. Consideration will be given to ACT test scores.
6. Must demonstrate a financial need.
7. Preference goes to those with a major that would permit the student to contribute to rural life.
8. Preference goes to those who actively participate in school activities.
9. Preference goes to those who actively participate in community service activities.
10. Must have ability to appear before, and speak to a group if necessary.
11. Must be accepted by and be able to start classes the fall after receiving scholarship.
12. Scholarship will go directly to student's account at an accredited college or university, not to the individual.
13. If for any reason, the student chosen does not go to an accredited college or university, the scholarship will not be given.
14. If chosen to receive scholarship, \$500 will be paid to the accredited college or university account after proof of registration for first semester is submitted. The additional \$500 will be paid to the accredited college or university account after proof of registration for second semester is submitted.
15. **Applications should reach the Grant County Conservation District office by Close of Business, Monday, March 29, 2021.**
