

GRANT COUNTY FARM BUREAU FEDERATION SCHOLARSHIP

The Grant County Farm Bureau Federation each year presents four \$1000.00 scholarships to students who are members or are in the household of members of the Grant County Farm Bureau Federation.

The scholarships will be awarded to graduating high school seniors and will be divided equally over the two semesters of your Freshman Year in college (\$500 each semester). The money will be paid directly to the winning students upon presenting their college letter of acceptance, their tuition receipt, and schedule at the Grant County Farm Bureau Office in Williamstown. For the second semester, a tuition receipt and schedule must also be presented at the Grant County Farm Bureau Office in Williamstown.

RULES

1. Applicant's family must be members of the Grant County Farm Bureau Federation.
2. The recipient of this award must enter college as a full-time student no later than the fall semester upon their high school graduation, unless unforeseen happenings prevent this. In the event of such situations, the student must enter college by the spring semester or forfeit his/her scholarship.
3. Completed application forms must be turned in to the guidance counselor's office at either Williamstown or Grant County High School or at the Grant County Farm Bureau Office in Williamstown located at 486 Helton Road. Applications turned in to any other place/person, will not be judged.
4. Members of the Grant Farm Bureau Federation Committee will judge applications.
5. The deadline for submitting the application will be May 7, 2021.
6. If no qualifying applications are received, the scholarship money will not be awarded.
7. Application must be received by the above date at the Grant County Farm Bureau Office in Williamstown.
