Must submit a resume to include:

- High school transcript with GPA for first 7 semesters—minimum GPA 2.5
- ACT score minimum of 20 or SAT score commensurate with ACT of 20
- College/university grad transcript (if applicable) minimum of 2.5 GPA
- Essay with reasons you need or deserve this grant/aid—maximum 2 page double-spaced
- List of honors or recognitions earned during high school
- 2 letters of recommendation from non-related sources
- List of KHSAA sports/activities you participated in during high school-1 sport/activity must be at the varsity level for 2 years
- List your community/school involvement (ex. tutoring, coaching, etc.)
- Provide a copy of an acceptance letter from an accredited school

The decision of the grant/aid committee will be final.
