If hospitalization is not appropriate, the clinician will provide short-term intensive therapy for a period of one to three weeks, which includes outpatient counseling, home/school visits and service coordination. Shelter reservations for the picnic areas in our local parks are offered for a fee of \$10.00. The money goes towards park improvement projects.




