The award will be based on a 250 to 500 word essay on a subject from the approved list. There are 5 topics to choose from.

- 1) Importance of Maintaining Infrastructure Systems (Parks, Roads, Sewer, Etc.)
- 2) Economic Impacts of Various Approaches to Solid Waste Management
- 3) Value of Park Systems In A Healthy Community
- 4) Managing The Effects of Rapid Development In A Public Works Department
- 5) Solid Waste Management In a Rural Community

#### **Eligibility Requirements**

- 1. Must be a U.S. Citizen
- 2. Must be a graduate of an accredited high school or home school in Northern Kentucky (Boone, Campbell, Carroll, Gallatin, Grant, Kenton, Owen, or Pendleton Counties)
- 3. Must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5
- 4. Preference given to students attending college or technical school in Kentucky
- 5. Must not have been arrested and convicted on a drug, weapon or violence charge
- 6. Must have verification of acceptance in a two or four year college or technical school for the upcoming fall semester before release of funds
- 7. Must be planning to study in a field similar to one of the following: engineering, construction management, solid waste management, or public administration.

### **Application Requirements**

Applicants must prepare a portfolio that includes the following:

- 1. Submission of a completed Scholarship Form.
- 2. Submission of a 250 minimum/500 word maximum essay
- 3. A letter of recommendation from a school administrator or teacher
