Action Component:	Substance Abuse Education and Counseling
Goal of Component:	To assist in the prevention of the use of alcohol, tobacco and other drugs (ATOD) and improve decision-making skills by educating students and families; and the reduction of ATOD use through coordination of counseling services and education.

Local Supporting Data

County/District Data: Fall 2013 Grant County Community held Stop Heroine Now Meeting with about 200 participants. Law enforcement, Court, and EMT reported increased use in our community of Heroine. Use of heroine is taxing all of these systems and individuals, and drug overdose is now the leading cause of death of adolescents and young adults in Northern Kentucky passing car accidents. The 2013 Kentucky YRBS Survey reported students having: used synthetic marijuana one or more times: 9th (10.2%, 10th (12.8%), 11th (19.9%), 12th (16.8); marijuana one or more times in the past 30 days: 9th (11.4%), 10th (15.8%), 11th (19.2%), 12th (25.4%); five or more drinks of alcohol in a row, that is, within a couple of hours, on one or more of the past 30 days: 9th (11.8), 10th (18.2), 11th (25.5%), 12th (23.4%).

School Data: Great News! From 2009-2012 GCHS participated in the Social Norms Tobacco Prevention Project. Students were surveyed in 2009 and then again in 2012 at the completion of the Social Norms Project. Results were : 2% decrease in students that said daily tobacco use is ok. Three percent (3%) decreased in students reporting they used tobacco daily. During the first half of the 2013-14 School Year YSC Staff have facilitated TEG Groups at GCHS, Eagle Creek, and GCMS totaling 30 students participates. Participants are referred when earning a Discipline Referral for tobacco.

FRYSC Data: GCYSC 2013 Parent Survey reported that 98% of parents having no needs for themselves or their children in the area of Substance Abuse and Education. Staff top two concerns are Parent ATOD abuse, Student ATOD abuse, specially student abuse of alcohol and prescription drugs. YSC worked with two teen parents who were abusing heroine.
