Amount: \$500

1. Must be a High School Graduate from Grant County or Williamstown Schools
2. Must enter a 2-year or 4-year college program of his or her choice.
3. To be eligible, a student must have a grade point standing of 2.5 or better for the last two semesters of high school.
4. Have a financial need.
5. Going into a field related to Agriculture, Conservation, or small rural business with preference given to those majoring in Agriculture or Conservation.
6. Fill out application and board possibly would like for them to come before them and state their goals.
7. Participate in school activities.
8. Participate in church and community activities.
9. Scholarship exists one year only.
10. Ability to appear before a group.
11. Parents willing for him or her to attend.
12. Student must maintain a GPA of 2.0 for the first semester of college.
13. Be pre-registered in college for second semester before receiving scholarship.
14. Money would be payable to college and individual after grades & registration are presented to the Cattlemen's Association.
15. If for any reason the student chosen does not go to college, the scholarship will not be given.
16. Consider score on ACT test.
